

NOTICE OF SOLICITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency, located at Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency, 13720 Butterfield Drive, Truckee, CA 96161, until 2:00 PM local time on the 1st day of October, 2020, or such later date as may be set by addendum, and then will be publicly opened and read for the construction of the following public works project:

2020 HEADWORKS IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The completed Work will provide Agency with new facilities and structures; improvements, modifications, expansions, and upgrades to existing facilities and structures; and Site improvements at the Water Reclamation Plant. The completed Work will provide Agency with new, improved, modified, and upgraded electrical and instrumentation and control systems. This Project includes, but is not limited to, the following major components of Work:

- New Structures: Upstream Diversion Structure, constructed on existing 33” diameter Truckee River Interceptor (sanitary sewer pipeline).
- Improvements, Modifications, and Expansions to Existing Facilities and Structures:
 - Facility 7 – Headworks Building. Building expansion, select demolition, channel modifications and improvements, mechanical and electrical system improvements.
 - Facility 27 – Electrical Supply Building. Addition of two breakers in Motor Control Center (MCC) 27-1 and MCC 27-2. Demolition of conductors feeding Facility 7.
 - Corridor 6C – Demolition of screen control panel and installation of an automatic transfer switch.
 - Plant Diversion Structure – Pipe penetration in existing structure.
- Site Improvements:
 - Site civil improvements.
 - Site yard piping.
 - Site electrical and instrumentation and control improvements.
- Miscellaneous Work items which are included in all construction activities and are not specifically identified in the Bid Schedule includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - Bypass pumping: The Work includes the provision, installation, operation, maintenance, breakdown, and removal of bypass piping and pumps to maintain uninterrupted sanitary sewer flows for the duration of the construction.
 - Temporary Facilities and Controls.
 - Mobilization, demobilization, bonds, insurance, cleanup, closeout, and any other tasks required for completion of the Project.

The contract documents for the Project, including the public works construction contract, instructions to bidders, bid forms, and plans and specifications, may be examined at the Agency office, with prior notice to the Agency’s representative, located at 13720 Butterfield Drive, Truckee, California 96161. An electronic copy of the contract documents may be obtained upon request free of charge. Alternatively, a printed copy of contract documents may be obtained at the

Agency's office upon request and payment of \$35. This payment is non-refundable. Bidders must comply with the Instructions to Bidders.

The Agency will hold a mandatory pre-bid conference at 10:00am on Tuesday, September 8, 2020, at the Tahoe-Truckee Sanitation Agency office. It is suggested that each prospective bidder review the bid documents and project site prior to the pre-bid conference. Each prospective bidder shall be required to attend the pre-bid conference. Bids from any bidder not attending this conference will be rejected as non-responsive.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed forms and accompanied by cash, a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form payable to the Agency in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a payment bond and faithful performance bond each in the full amount of the Contract price, and insurance with certificates and endorsements of insurance, as provided in the Contract Documents. The required bonds must be provided only by a surety insurer who is admitted to do business by and in good standing with the California Department of Insurance.

Bidders are hereby notified that in accordance with Public Contract Code section 22300, securities may be substituted for any monies that the Agency may withhold pursuant to the terms of this Contract to ensure performance.

The successful bidder must possess the following classification or type of contractor's license issued by the California Contractors State License Board: Class A.

To be qualified to bid on this Project, bidders must be registered and qualified to perform public work with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. All subcontractors listed in a qualified bidder's bid as performing any portion of the work also must be registered and qualified with the Department of Industrial Relations.

Bids that equal or exceed \$1,000,000 must be accompanied by an Iran Contracting Act certification in the form provided in section 1.9 of the Contract Documents.

The attention of bidders is directed to the requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid to all workers employed under the Contract in accordance with Labor Code sections 1770 and following. Copies of the prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the Agency's office, and will be made available to any interested party on request. In accordance with Labor Code section 1771.4(a)(1), this project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The Agency reserves the right to reject all bids. Any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents may be rejected. The Agency may extend the time to award the Contract. The Work shall be performed within the following dates:

Mobilize to Site (no earlier than):	May 3, 2021
Substantial Completion:	October 29, 2021
Final Completion:	December 3, 2021
